# What Is The Living Well Collective?

Supportive living, reimagined.

The Living Well Collective is a curated supportive living community for adults who deserve dignity, beauty, belonging, and gentle support. We are expanding in the Indianapolis area with homes designed to feel like sanctuary — not facility.

## What Makes Us Different

- **Sanctuary, not facility.** Our homes are intentionally designed for comfort, beauty, and warmth. Environment shapes wellbeing.
- **Dignity at every income level.** We serve residents with private funding, SSI, SSDI, Veterans Benefits, and more. Subsidized funding is available so cost is never the barrier.
- **Community as medicine.** Belonging, companionship, shared meals, and ordinary shared moments are treated as essential sources of restoration.
- **The whole person comes first.** Residents are understood through their stories, preferences, independence, and humanity — not reduced to diagnoses or limitations.

## Daily Life in a TLWC Home

Residents enjoy a structured yet gentle daily rhythm: morning routines, shared meals, community activities, and quiet time. Our homes feature comfortable shared living spaces, well-appointed bedrooms, and an atmosphere that feels like home. Residents maintain independence while benefiting from compassionate oversight and community connection.

## Our Community Partner

We've partnered with **Help In Your Home LLC**, a licensed home care provider in Indianapolis, to offer optional support services for residents who need assistance with daily living activities, companionship, non-emergency medical transportation, and meal

preparation. These services are arranged separately and tailored to each resident's needs.

# What's Included

Everything residents need for a comfortable, dignified life.

# Who We Serve

For adults who need gentle support — not a facility.

Our homes are designed for adults who benefit from routine, community, and compassionate oversight while maintaining their independence and dignity.

## Ideal Resident Profile

- Ambulatory and able to move independently or with minimal assistance
- Cognitively aware, able to communicate needs and respond in emergencies
- Benefits from routine, structure, and community
- Behaviorally stable — no acute crisis needs
- Committed to a substance-free community environment
- Has a secure income source (SSI, SSDI, Veterans Disability, VA Pension, Survivor Benefits, Retirement Income, or private pay)

## Who Is Not a Fit

- Individuals requiring skilled nursing or 24-hour medical care
- Individuals with active substance use that would disrupt the community
- Individuals who are non-ambulatory or bed-bound
- Individuals in acute psychiatric crisis requiring inpatient-level care

**Subsidized funding is available for individuals who cannot afford the full monthly rate.** Cost should never be the reason a qualified resident cannot access dignified, supportive housing. Contact us to discuss options.

# Cost & Subsidized Funding

Dignity shouldn't depend on income.

## Monthly Rate

The monthly rate is **\$1,200 per bed**, which includes housing, utilities, housekeeping, laundry, medication reminders, daily routines, house manager oversight, community activities, and family communication.

## Subsidized Program Funding

For individuals who cannot afford the full \$1,200 monthly rate, The Living Well Collective has subsidized program funding to help cover the difference. This means qualified residents with lower income levels — including those on fixed SSI or SSDI — can still access our homes without cost being a barrier.

## How to Apply for Subsidized Funding

- Indicate on the referral form that the resident needs subsidized funding
- We'll verify income source and amount during the intake process
- Subsidy is determined case-by-case based on income and need
- Documentation needed: proof of income (benefit award letter, pay stubs, or bank statements)

## Optional Services Billing

Services through Help In Your Home LLC (personal care, transportation, companionship, meal preparation) are billed separately from the monthly housing rate. These can be coordinated through the resident, their family, or their case manager, and may be covered by Medicaid Waiver or private pay depending on the service.

Every situation is unique, and we'll help you find the right path.

# The Referral Process

You connect us. We handle the rest.

We've designed our intake to be simple and fast — because when you have a client who needs housing, time matters.

1

## Referral

Submit a referral by phone, email, or using the referral form in this packet. Include the client's name, income source, and a brief description of their needs.

2

## Income Verification

We verify the client's income source and amount to confirm eligibility and determine if subsidized funding is needed.

3

## Assessment & Interview

The client meets with our House Manager for an assessment and/or interview to confirm they meet our resident profile — ambulatory, cognitively aware, behaviorally stable, and a good community fit.

4

## Placement Decision

Our House Manager makes the final placement decision. We'll communicate the outcome to you and the client promptly.

5

## Move-In Coordination

Once approved, we coordinate move-in logistics — timing, transportation, and any optional support services through Help In Your Home.

**Timeline:** We are currently building our referral network ahead of upcoming openings. Once openings are available, we'll move quickly through intake and placement — and referrals already in our pipeline will be prioritized. Submit referrals now so your clients are first in line when beds become available.
